Role description

Being a key part of the team making Electric Youth sessions exciting, fun, safe and spiritually nourishing.

Responsibilities

Sundays

- Being an active member of the Electric Youth team, serving on Sundays and/or Friday evening sessions.
 - Being involved in the teenagers spiritual growth in discussion, sharing Bible messages and leading them in prayer.
 - Being a part of setting up and packing down the space: getting it ready for activities, ensuring it is safe and leaving it clean and tidy.
 - Adhering to and ensuring that safeguarding procedures are followed well.

2. Successful applicants will be invited to interview
3. Applicants invited to interview will also be asked to fill out a Self disclosure form to self-report any relevant criminal convictions, child protection investigations or disciplinary sanctions which they will bring in a sealed envelope, only opened if the applicant is successful at interview.
4. If selected at interview for the role, the following checks will take place:
 - a. Enhanced DBS and barred list check
 - b. Right to Work (for paid roles)
 - c. Overseas checks
5. Depending on the role, applicants may be asked to participate in a practical session to demonstrate suitability.
